

Vastint statement under Modern Slavery Act 2015

Vastint Holding B.V. – Modern Slavery Act statement

This statement constitutes the slavery and human trafficking statement for the Vastint Group of companies, i.e. Vastint Holding B.V. and its subsidiaries, (“**Vastint**”) for the financial year ending 31st December 2019, as required by section 54 of the Modern Slavery Act 2015.

Vastint is an international real estate organisation with 30 years of experience. The goal of Vastint is to create long-term value through property investments. The cornerstones of Vastint’s operations are the management of portfolio properties and the development of commercial real estate, including residential development and sales. Development activities include land acquisition, master planning, design, construction and leasing. Vastint is active in many countries across Europe, including the UK.

As at 31st December 2019 Vastint had 162 direct employees. Vastint also appoints a large number of consultants, contractors and suppliers in order to support its activities. Vastint considers that its most significant risk areas in relation to slavery and human trafficking lie in its supply chain, particularly those involved in construction and/or the sourcing of construction materials.

Vastint is committed to ensuring that its group companies and supply chain meet the highest ethical standards. Vastint conducts its activities in accordance with the Interogo Holding Code of Conduct which sets out the standards it expects from all those involved in its activities, including prohibiting forced labour, providing a safe and healthy working environment, prohibiting all forms of harassment and discrimination, and generally acting in an ethical, honest, fair and respectful manner. Vastint’s suppliers are contractually obliged to comply with the Interogo Holding Code of Conduct and new employees are also trained on its contents. In the UK, Vastint has also included specific clauses in its contracts which require suppliers to confirm that they share Vastint’s values and approach to human rights issues.
